### History of Area 14 North Florida District 17

The following Directory Listings are some of the earliest for District 17 in our collections:

- One of the earliest groups in our records from Area 14 District 17 was a group in Ocala, Florida named the *Ocala Group*. The group was first listed with the G.S.O. in the August 1946 A.A. Group Directory. The secretary for the group was J.A.R.S. and the number of members was unknown.
- The next listing is for the *Belleview Group* of Belleview, Florida. The group was first listed in the 1977 Eastern United States A.A. Directory. The contacts for the group were Georgia W. and Steve C. The number of members was listed as 10. The group would meet on Fridays.
- The earliest listing in our collections for a group in Dunnellon, Florida was listed in the 1977 Eastern United States A.A. Directory. The name of the group was listed as the *Dunnellon Group* and the contacts were Ed McD. and W.B. The number of members was listed as 8. The group would meet on Sundays.
- The earliest listing for a group in Anthony, Florida was the *Winners Circle Group*. The group was listed in the 1983 Eastern United States A.A. Directory. The contacts for the group were Jerry B., and John P. and the number of members was not listed. The group would meet on Wednesdays and Fridays.
- One of the earliest listings for Silver Springs, Florida is the *Forrest Group*. The group was listed in the 1994-1995 Eastern United States A.A. Directory and had Mae Y., and Victor M. listed as contacts. The number of members was not listed, and the group would meet on Sundays.
- The earliest listing for a group in Fort McCoy, Florida was the *Fort McCoy Group*. The group was listed in the 2000-2001 Eastern United States A.A. Directory. The contact for the group was Eric A., and the group would meet on Mondays. There was also a lone member in Fort McCoy, Paul McC., who was listed in the 1998-1999 Eastern United States A.A. Directory.

Our collections hold a letter from Ocala Group Secretary J.A.R.S. to the Alcoholic Foundation of July 31<sup>st</sup>, 1946. The letter reads:

"After having been affiliated with the Alcoholic Anonymous group in Daytona Beach for some time, we feel that there is an urgent need for organizing a group in Ocala."

One of the earliest records we have in our collections for the Dunnellon Group is a Handbook Form from April 11<sup>th</sup>, 1977. The form provided the following information about the group:

The next correspondence is a letter from Harry G. to a General Service Office Staff member named Eileen from January 26<sup>th</sup>, 1984, which included a list of meetings held in District 17. The list included the names of the following groups: Winner's Circle, 305 Club, Open Door, Serenity, TLC, Ocala Group, Anthony Group, Alanon, Belleview, Ocala Grace, Oxford Group, and Marion Oaks Saturday Night Group. The meeting information that was listed for these groups is as follows:

Group Directories starting in August 1946 and these directories provide the following information for the first few years the group was listed:
