In January of 2008 I inquired about any information your office might have regarding meditation groups. Ms Michelle Mirza kindly replied and sent me some GV articles as well as parts of two letters by Bill W. regarding the subject. Interestingly enough, both letters alluded to meditation meetings in Florida.

In September of 2005 we held the first meeting of the Conscious Contact group of AA. It has met every Wednesday night since then with an attendance of between 8 and 25, averaging probably 12. It might be greater but our meeting follows the daily 5:30-6:30 meeting, one of the largest groups in town. We meet from 7:00 to 8:00 PM, a time when many are at home with the family, eating dinner or taking their ease in front of the 'tube'. We offer only coffee and candlelight as enticements.

We've enjoyed quite a cross section of attendees with lots of different reactions. We had one guy who came in still shaking. But by the end of the meeting he had calmed down considerably. We've had everything from people with painful physical problems to Christian preachers. We've had some who could only be described as 'savage'. They looked for any excuse to decry the meeting and leave. One did so after I forgot to unlock the bathrooms before the meeting. He thought we did it on purpose! But we've also had many who have brightened and flowered visibly as a result of attendance. They are the reason we keep on keepin' on. One thing stands out from our experience—regular attendance at a meditation meeting greatly enhances the spiritual growth of those in early sobriety. (And it ain't bad for us old timers, either.)

I am attaching a copy of our meeting guide. It took a few years to iron out the wrinkles. But the result has served us well. Almost anyone can chair our meeting. Feel free to copy it to any interested parties. Or refer them to me at the above address or email.

Probably our greatest asset has been that two of our members are also members of a local yoga ashram. They have 10 and 24 years of sobriety respectively and have been kind enough to lead the majority of our 20 minute guided meditations. Their technique keeps one's consciousness centered in the physical body. So, since we all have a body, the technique has proven both easy and effective, as well as non-denominational. I am sure they are glad that their attendance

at the ashram has also given them such an opportunity for service in AA. Some of our members have even become 'certified' teachers of this meditative technique and have joined in the rotation for leading the meditations. And the ashram, situated on the shores of a beautiful lake in the middle of a National Forest, is a wonderful, peaceful place for hosting AA retreats.

Often we try to relate the meditation to the topic of the night. And the topic is always from the 12 & 12. This is an AA meeting with a guided meditation attached at the end of the discussion. By the way, it takes us about a year to get through Steps 1 through 12 because our discussions are often much deeper than in regular AA meetings, and with lots of 'double dipping'. Often we may only read 2 or 3 paragraphs. No one seems to mind.

Chairperson's meeting guide

7:00 PM "Welcome to the Conscious Contact group of Alcoholics Anonymous. My name is _____ and I am happy to be your chairperson. Before we begin, please turn off or silence your cell phone.

"We begin the meeting with a short 'centering' Please sit upright in your chair, with your back erect but not rigid. Close your eyes and take a few deep, slow, cleansing breaths. With each outbreath, allow yourself to relax a little more—releasing all the tension you've been carrying within you. With each breath, your consciousness, which has been scattered all around the Universe, is returning.....back into your body, sitting there in your chair. As you become centered, your breathing becomes slower and shallower. Your mind is becoming peaceful and content to just be where you are... in your body... HERE... NOW. This is a safe place. We have a purpose for being here. So for the next hour, just be HERE... ..Continue breathing slowly. In about a minute we will open the meeting with the 'We' version of the Serenity Prayer. You may want to use this time to open yourself to your Higher Power."

(Wait 30 to 60 seconds. Then...)

"God,
Grant us the serenity to accept the things we cannot change,
The courage to change the things we can,
And the wisdom to know the difference."

Anonymity Announcement:

This is an open meeting of Alcoholics Anonymous and some of those present may not be members of AA. The concept of anonymity is one of our most valued traditions. We prefer to remain anonymous in our relationship with the public. We therefore urge all present to respect each other's anonymity outside of AA circles.

(Welcome)

At this time we welcome visitors to the meeting. If you are visiting us for the first time, please introduce yourself.

(Chips)

Before we begin our book study, we pass out chips and medallions to members who have an anniversary this week. Has any member earned a 3, 6 or 9 month chip? Does any member have an AA anniversary this week?

(Literature study)

This is an AA meeting in which we experience the meditation part of the 11th Step. First we read from some AA literature, discussing each paragraph in as much depth as we like, keeping the discussion in AA context. The discussion is followed by a guided meditation of approximately 20 minutes. Lights are dimmed and soft music is played during the meditation. Then we finish up the hour by sharing any insights or revelations we may have experienced while meditating

Before we begin the literature study, we pass the basket in co-operation with our 7th Tradition.

(**Begin the literature study** portion of the meeting by opening to the paragraph where the group left off at the last meeting. Give plenty of time for in-depth discussion of each paragraph. Double dipping, even crosstalk, is common at this meeting. But do not allow anyone to ramble on and on. Maintain the discussion in an AA context always.)

(**At approximately 7:30**, wind up the literature discussion and begin the meditation portion of the meeting as follows:)

From page 101 of the 12 and 12:

'Meditation can always be further developed. It has no boundaries. Aided by such instruction and example as we can find, it is essentially an individual adventure. But its object is always the same—to improve our conscious contact with our Higher Power.'

For our 'instruction and example' this evening, we have _____. Before you begin the meditation, please introduce yourself and tell us a little about how you came to be here in AA, leading a meditation. (Turn meeting over to meditation leader at this time.)

(When the leader is ready, at approx 7:35, dim the lights to begin the meditation.)

(At approximately 7:55 the meditation will end.)

Would anyone like to share about your meditation?....

Are there any announcements for the good of AA?....

Are there any announcements regarding local retreats or activities not AA oriented but which may be helpful in continuing our spiritual growth?

If there is nothing further, let's thank _____ for the meditation.

There is no time limit on use of the room. However, some may need to leave at 8 o'clock, so we will wind up the meeting at this time. But you are free to remain after the meeting to socialize and share.

I hope to see you all here next week. You are welcome to bring your sponsor, sponsee or a friend.

We end with a final quote from page 98 of the '12 and 12':

"There is a direct linkage between self-examination, meditation and prayer. When they are logically related and interwoven, the result is an unshakeable foundation for life."

Let's close with the Prayer for Protection:

'The Light of God surrounds us.

The Love of God enfolds us.

The Power of God protects us.

The Presence of God watches over us.

Wherever we are, God is. And all is well.'

(Procedure for closing up the room:

Turn lights on. Return the AA literature, etc to the cabinet.

Turn off the coffee maker and hot plate. Empty coffee grounds and all coffee pots. Put coffee supplies into cabinet.

Remove any trash. Put in new trash bags. Turn off lights. Lock cabinet, bathrooms, meeting room.)

FORMATION AND HISTORY

- As a Result of the Global SARS-CoV-2 Pandemic the Weir Crazy AA Group meeting location in Weirsdale, FL was “temporarily” closed in March 2020 by the landlord. On the day the closed notice was posted on the building by two Home Group members (Scott M & Dan F) 5 people showed up expecting a meeting so 7 people met outside under the shade of an Oak Tree. Included in this impromptu group was a person two days out of jail with two months of sobriety who expressed a desire to continue involvement in Alcoholics Anonymous.
- With the AA Responsibility Statement and AA Preamble as our impetus and guide we decided that meetings should continue to be available and that they could be held outside within the guidelines established by Federal, State, and Local governments. With help from the District 17 Central Office/Intergroup we secured an outdoor space behind the Disabled American Veterans building in Belleview, FL and held our first meeting on a Wednesday at 6:00pm beginning in mid- April, 2020 using an Open Topic Discussion Format.
- This Group had no name, written meeting guidelines, collection basket, bathroom facilities, nor COFFEE POT, etc! We did recite the AA Preamble, read How It Works and the 9th Step Promises from the Book Alcoholics Anonymous and used a hat(literally!) for collections which initially went to District 17 Central Office/Intergroup and to reimburse members who brought coffee. From a small group of 8-10 the meeting quickly grew to 30+ attending regularly so following CDC Guidelines we met in 3 groups of 10 each.
- By the end of the Summer 2020 the group had expanded from Wednesdays to 6:00pm Friday Big Book and 6:00pm Monday Twelve Steps and Twelve Traditions formats respectfully. During the Fall of 2020 a 6:00pm Tuesday Speaker/Discussion and 10:00am Sunday 11th Step/Meditation Formats were added.
- As it became more evident that indoor meetings would be closed indefinitely the group relied on our Traditions for guidance and began

donating a percentage of collections to the Disabled American Veterans for rent and General Service Office(GSO) suggested percentage contributions to Central Office/Intergroup, District 17, Area 14, and our GSO. We also decided that this no name group would become the Rule #62 Group, Belleview, FL.

- As some District 17 groups began to reopen meetings in 2021, we switched the Monday Twelve Steps and Twelve Traditions to Wednesdays and the Open Topic/Discussion to Mondays to not interfere with a nearby meeting in Summerfield, FL.
